It is always a privilege to greet you all in the name of our Lord! It is our hope and prayer that God is blessing your lives, families and churches, and that He is using you for His glory! At this time, I want to tell you how the work in Arequipa has progressed during the past 3 months.

The Work in Arequipa

Glory to God, we have had the opportunity to continue on with our Bible studies in the city of Yanque. We are travelling to Yanque once a month (it is between a 3- and 4-hour trip) to have Bible studies with Bro. Basilio Ninataipe's family and friends. In our last Bible study, we had 25 people gathered together. We were very thankful to be able to use a projector which was given to us by Bro. Nathaniel Hille, pastor of The Bible Baptist Church in Plant City, Florida. Please keep praying for the people in this city, that God would be merciful to them and save them by His grace!

In the month of July, we also started 3 new programs: our adolescent program, ladies' program, and sports evening. We are having our adolescent and ladies' program simultaneously on Saturday mornings. We have been having approximately 20 teens and we are studying the book of Proverbs with them. Please keep these young people in your prayers, so God will work in their lives. My wife is directing the ladies' program and they are studying "Christian Family Principles." Several ladies are responding very positively and are sharing how God is convicting their lives in different areas.

On Monday evenings, we have started getting together to play soccer. Right across the street from our church building, there is a school and a soccer field, which we rent. The teen boys and men are inviting their friends, and each week we are having between 15 and 20 people. After playing soccer, we have a Bible study with those who come. We are thankful for this time of fellowship and for
