

Camp

The biggest event that we are preparing for right now is our youth camp at the end of July! This is the 2nd youth camp that we are organizing and we are very excited to see what God will do. Glory to God, so far, we have received \$3,500 dollars to help out with camp! Our church has also raised \$1,000 dollars for camp. We still need approximately \$2,000 dollars to help cover basic needs. Since covid, prices have skyrocketed. We are trying to find ways to cut back on expenses. There is a weather phenomenon that is causing the weather to drop, and we have had to buy several gas heaters for camp. We are attempting to stamp (on our own) the t-shirts that we will hand out as prizes. Bibles have also been purchased to hand out to the winning teens from each cabin.

We ask that you would please help us pray that God would provide what we need and that He would bless this endeavor. Our biggest goal is to reach more young people and have an impact on their lives. We want to preach the gospel to them and help them make decisions that would bring glory to His name. We have already received messages from teens in several different cities in Peru that are planning on coming!

We want to thank Lakes Pond Baptist Church in Connecticut, Sovereign Grace Baptist Church in Idaho, Heritage Baptist Church in Ohio, Calvary Baptist Church in Illinois and others for their love offerings for camp. Thank you all so very much and may our Lord richly bless you! Thank you so much for investing in our young people's future! Construction Project

Last year our church was able to buy land and now we are trying to raise offerings for the construction. Praise the Lord, we currently have almost \$7,000 dollars for construction. A constructor that we met with gave us a calculation of \$80,000 dollars (this includes the termination of the first floor, without finishings, but with a foundation that could hold up to 3 floors). Please help us pray! This is an impossible feat on our own, but we know full well that with our Lord nothing is impossible!

Our Family

We want to praise the Lord of His protection and grace! As I mentioned in previous letters, we moved to another house in a different neighborhood mostly because of safety concerns. We found out that just a few weeks after moving, thieves broke into the old house that we used to live in. And just a couple blocks from the old house, several houses have been robbed at gunpoint. God is very good in protecting our family from this!

In the month of June, we had to drive to Cusco, which is 8 hours away from Arequipa, to get our youngest child's Birth Abroad Certificate and American passport. We are also still trying to get our oldest's Social Security number. Praise the Lord, the trip and appointment went well.

We have had several birthdays in the family. Our children keep growing! Please pray for their salvation and spiritual growth in the Lord!

Andy will soon be starting high school! We already ordered his books so that Pastor Jennette from Illinois can bring them down when he comes for camp. Andy is being enrolled in an accredited Christian school, but will be doing all the school work at home. This cost \$860 dollars.

There have been lots of extra expenses over the past couple of months, but God always provides. We are very thankful for Bryan Station Baptist Church in Kentucky for sending an offering of \$850 dollars so that we could buy a gas dryer! In our last letter, we mentioned that our dryer had stopped working, but praise the Lord, this need has been met!

As many of you know, I also teach online Spanish classes to missionaries and preachers. I have also taught Spanish to high school and grade school students in small schools in churches. Some of our students have finished the program and we are looking for new students. This helps pay the bills and also helps out with expenses that come up in the ministry! If you know of anyone who is wanting to learn Spanish, please pass our information along.
